Point and read each sentence. Circle the spelling word.</p> <p>Phonemic Awareness Write 5 Words that start with Ll. Draw a picture to go with each word you wrote.</p>	<p>Thursday 25</p> <p>Spelling Words –zero, one, two, three, four Write each word out of order. Underline the first letter of each as a starting point. Unscramble each word. Example: mat , atrm = mat</p> <p>Math – Patterning Review AABB patterns. Pick two shapes and 2 colors and draw an AABB pattern.</p>

Trace each word with a different color crayons.</p> <p>Writing Practice – Write Pp 10 times each. Go across the page, use a finger space between each letter. Write all capitals, then all the lower case letters.</p>	<p>Tuesday 30</p> <p>Spelling Words –five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten Say your spelling words, spell them and clap them as you say each letter. Say them again. Then say each letter as you write them. Write and say each word 3 times.</p> <p>Math – 2's or Pairs Draw and write 5 objects that are in pairs. Ex. Draw a picture to go with each word you wrote.</p>	<p>Thursday 1</p> <p>Spelling Words –five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten Write each word out of order. Underline the first letter of each as a starting point. Unscramble each word.</p> <p>Math –Counting Backwards Practice counting backwards from 20 – 1. Write it backwards 2 times. Start with 20, 19 ect</p>
