

# Morning Work before the Bell

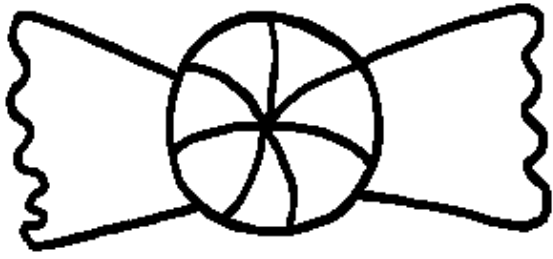

These activities have been used in my classroom for many years. I have passed them around to other teachers as an alternative for worksheets. I blow these up on the copier or just use them the size that they are. I then teach the children how to fold newsprint paper to make it look like mine. I then teach them to draw the black lines for boxes. The first few times, I color the sheets in so the child can see what I want theirs to look like. It still amazes me how children can really draw and color at such an early age. These activities improve fine motor skills, color recognition, number recognition, letter recognition, sound recognition, and language. Please feel free to use these how you see fit in your classroom. Once you start using this style of work, the sky is the limit. In a few days, your children will enter the classroom, fold their paper, and start their morning work on their own. I love to walk around the room and assess children as they are working so I can pull small groups for remediation. 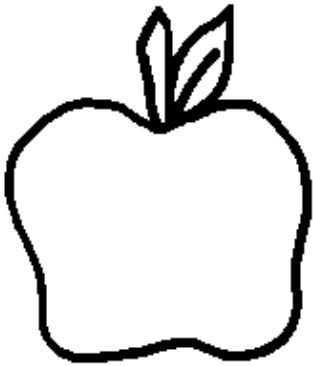

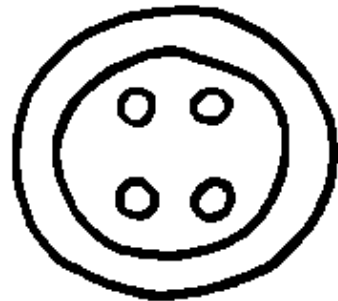

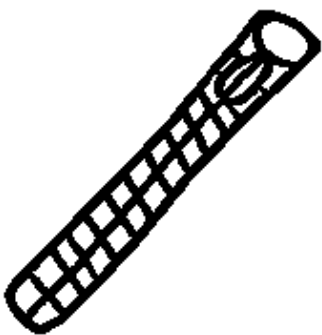
